

**LIST OF EPA CERTIFIED AND EPA EXEMPT STOVES, INSERTS AND FIREPLACES -
WASHINGTON STATE (STATE REGULATION), USA (NATIONAL-EPA) AND CANADA (NATIONAL-CSA B-415)****EPA CERTIFIED APPLIANCES****EPA (Environmental Protection Agency) Emission Standards**

To be Phase II EPA certified, stack emissions are limited to the following:

- 7.5 grams of particulates per hour for non-catalytic models.
- 4.1 grams per hour for catalytic models.

NOTE: Washington state has more stringent regulations for maximum grams per hour emissions allowed (included in table below). Check with your local authority having jurisdiction for requirements in your area.
