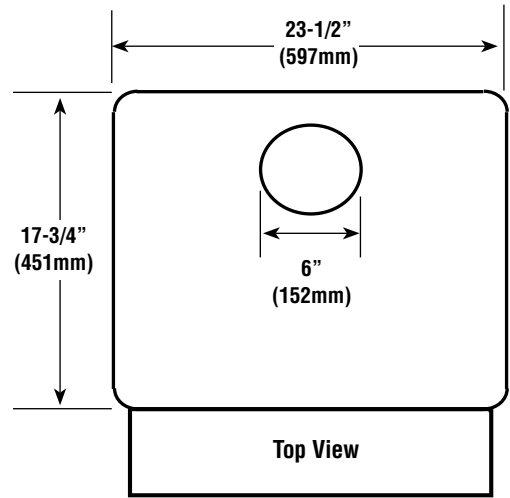


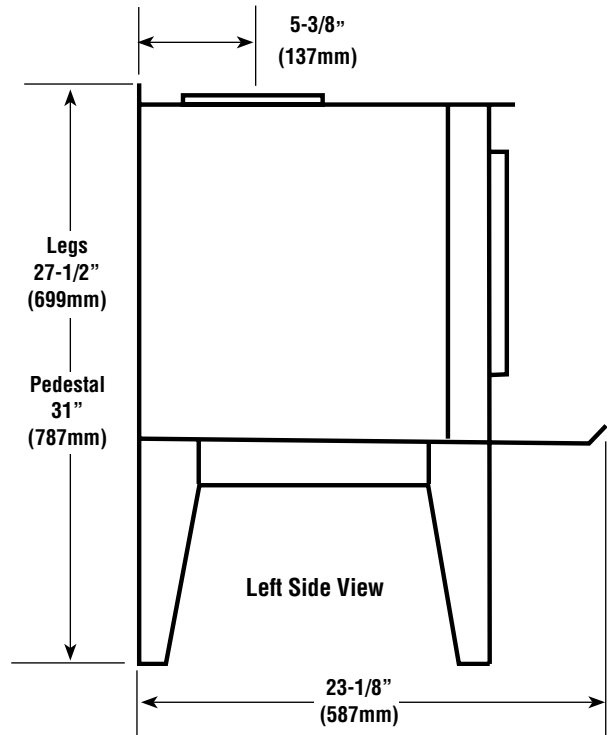

Diagram A: Top View-Parallel Installation

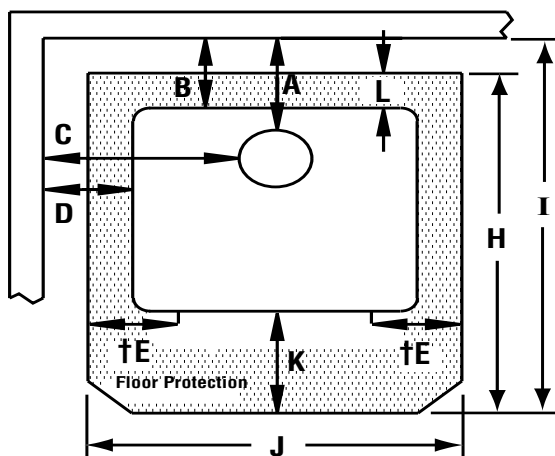


Diagram B: Side View-Alcove & Parallel Installation

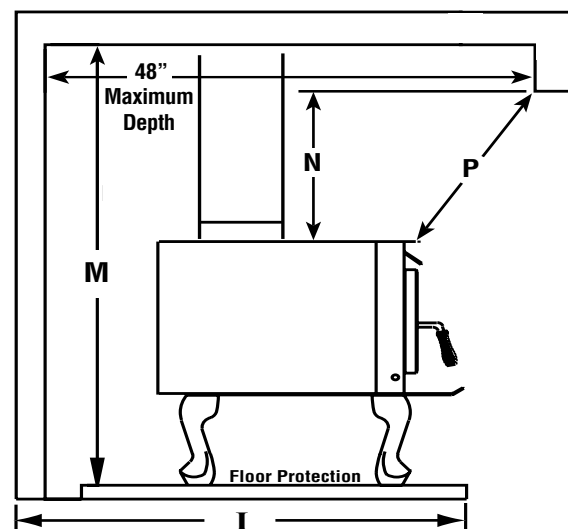
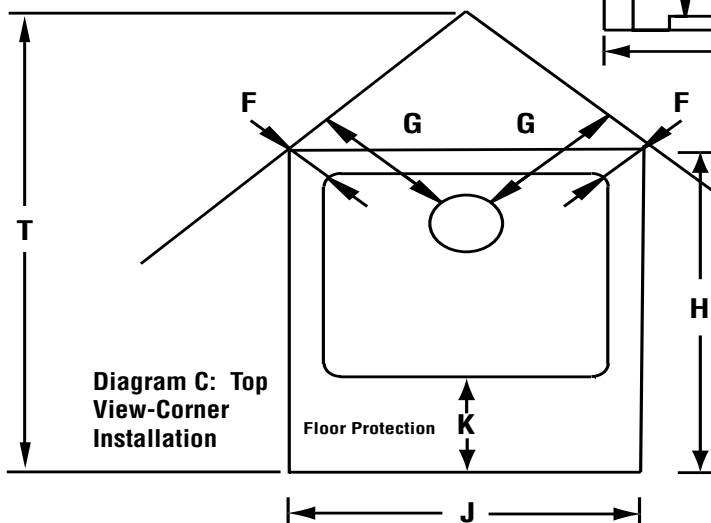


Diagram C: Top View-Corner Installation



Footnotes:

2. Minimum noncombustible hearth pad dimensions.
3. Shield shall be attached to the rear of the stove pipe with a 1" air space and must run from the top of the stove to the ceiling.
4. Not applicable to alcove installations.

Clearances to connector pipe shall be measured from the flue collar of the stove.



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
