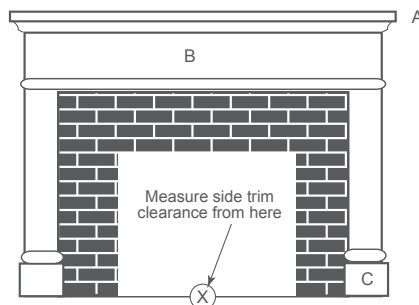
CLEARANCES

Measure the side clearance (C) from the exact center of your fireplace opening on the hearth (X). Measure the top trim (B) and/or mantel clearances (A) from the finished hearth surface. Measure the front clearance (to furnishings, etc.) from the fireplace face.

FLUSH MOUNT	
(A) MANTEL (12") ⁴	47-1/2" (1207 mm)
(B) TOP TRIM (3/4")	34-3/4" (883 mm)
(C) SIDE TRIM ⁵	23-3/4" (616 mm)

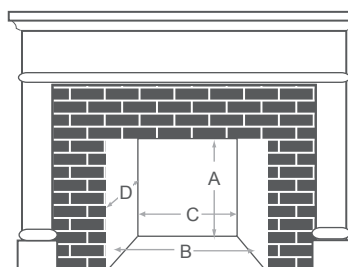
4: Clearance shown is for 12" (305 mm) deep mantel. Clearances may be reduced for shallower mantels; refer to the installation manual for reduced dimensions.

5: For Montpelier II, where side trim extends more than 3" (76mm) from the fireplace facing, the side clearance must be no less than 24-1/4" (616 mm); this is also the required side wall clearance.
