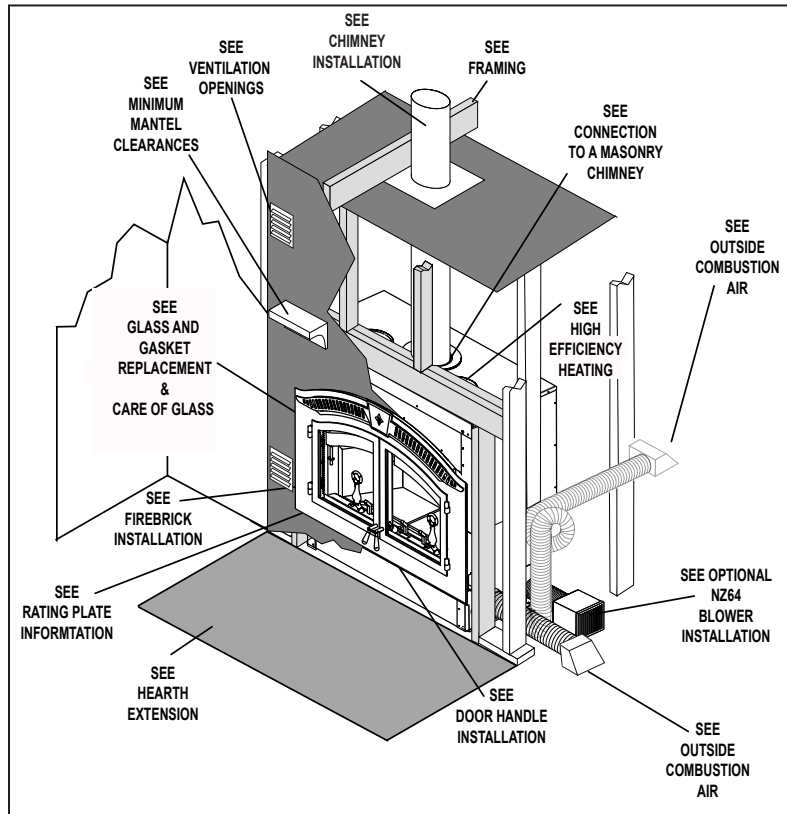

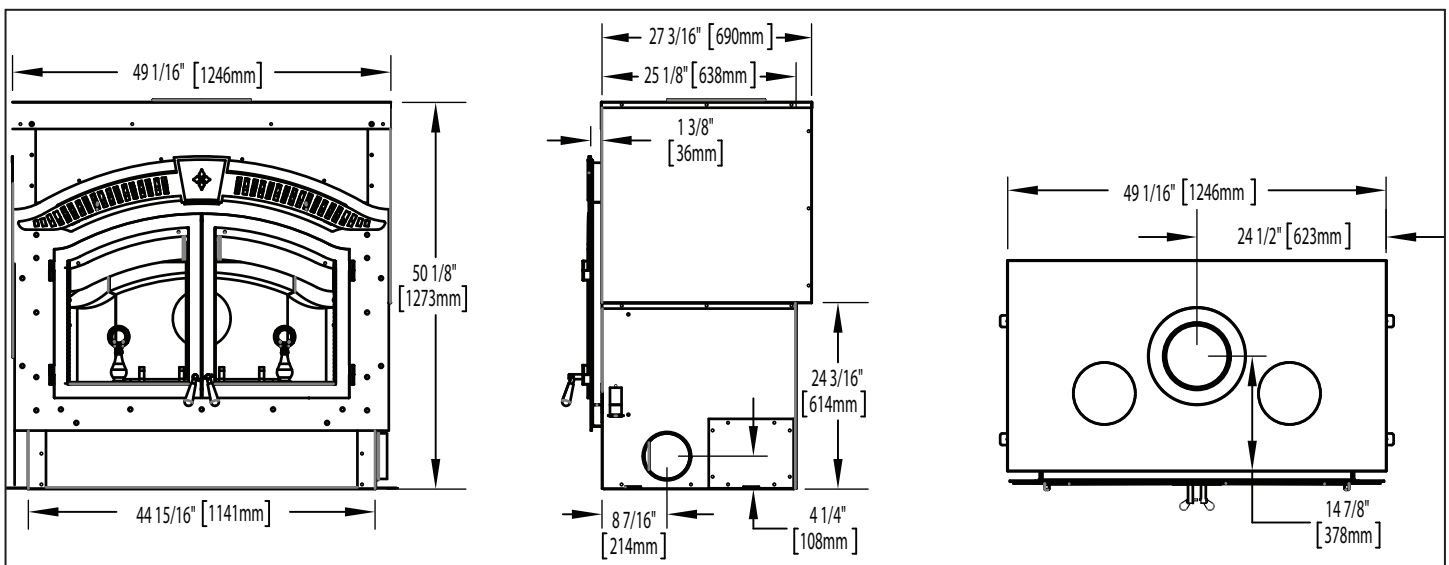

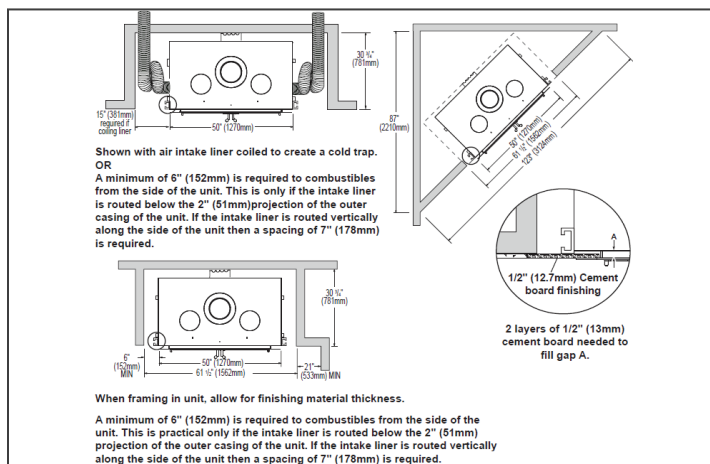

Framing & Clearances

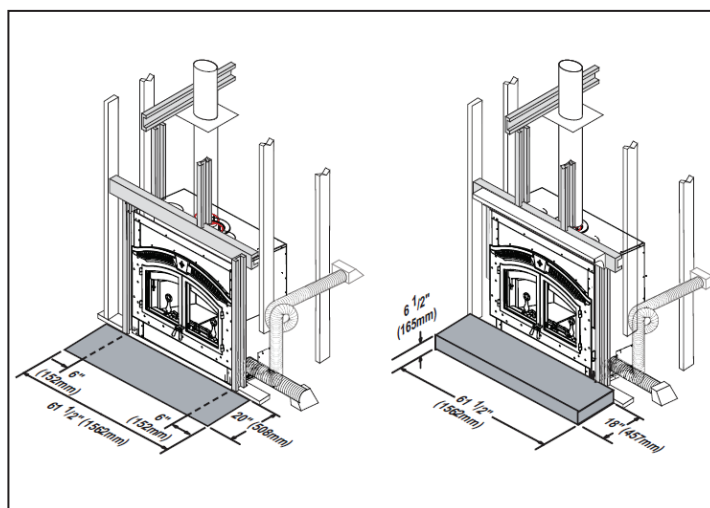
Minimum Fireplace Clearances

Framed Enclosure	
Rear	- 0" (0mm) to stand-offs (rear)
Sides	- 6" (152mm) to sides*
Ceiling (enclosure)	- 120" (3048mm) from the base of the appliance (unless shielded with metal studs and cement board)
Ceiling (in front of appliance)	- 84" (2134mm) from the base of the appliance
Chimney	- 2" (51mm) (follow manufacturers instructions)
Hot air Gravity Ductwork Insulation	- 1" (25mm)
Solid Pack Chimney	
Ceiling (enclosure)	- 120" (3048mm) from the base of the appliance (unless shielded with metal studs and cement board).
Air Cooled	
Ceiling (enclosure)	- 84" (2134mm) from the base of the appliance

Appliance Location

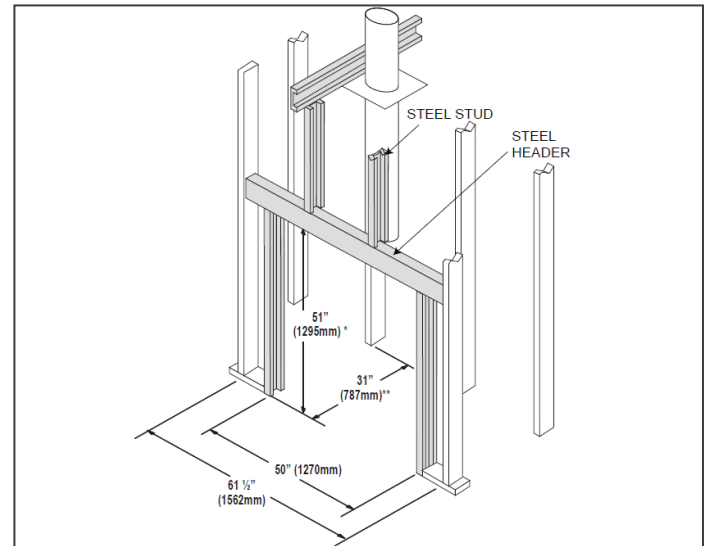


Hearth Extension

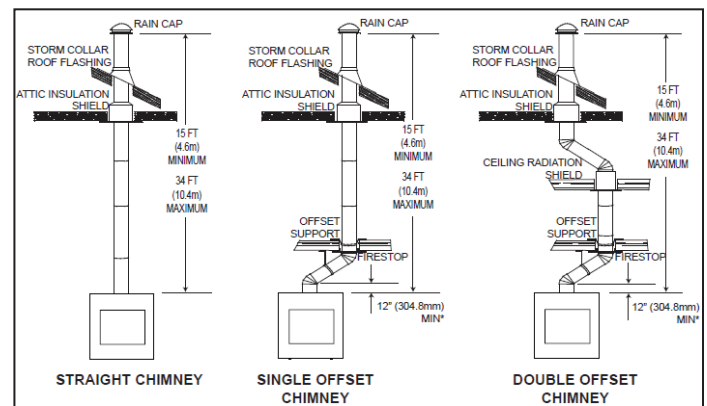

Combustible Mantel Clearances

An optional combustible mantel must be a minimum of 12" (305mm) above the top of the faceplate and not to extend more than 2" (51mm) from the surface. See chart below for further information.
